# THREE CARD POKER

Rules and Guidelines



## AIM OF THE GAME

Three Card Poker is a version of Poker using a single deck of 52 cards that gives you three different ways to play. The object of the game is to obtain a 3-card poker hand with a value higher than the dealer's hand. In order for the dealer to qualify, the dealer's hand should have Queen high or better. The player may choose to play a combination of 'Ante/Play' and 'Pair Plus' options.

## HOW TO PLAY

Three cards are dealt to each betting box containing a wager on 'Ante' or on "Pair Plus" and three cards to the Dealer. After players have examined their cards, players must decide to either:

- Place a wager on 'Play' equal to the amount of the 'Ante' wager.
- Fold. This action forfeits the 'Ante' bet and any 'Pair Plus' bet.
- If the dealer does not qualify with Queen high or better, the player's ante bet is paid even money and the play bet is returned.
- If the dealer qualifies with Queen high or better and the player's hand beats the dealer's hand, the player's ante and play bets are paid even money respectively.
- If the dealer qualifies with Queen high or better and the player's hand is equal to the dealer's hand, the player's ante and play bets are returned (standoff)
- If the dealer qualifies with Queen high or better and the player's hand is of lesser rank than the dealer's hand, the player's ante and play bets lose.

## ANTE BONUS PAYOUT

### **Odds**

Straight Flush	5 to 1
Three of a Kind	4 to 1
Straight	1 to 1

### **Pair Plus Payout Odds**

Straight Flush	40 to 1
Three of a Kind	25 to 1
Straight	5 to 1
Flush	4 to 1
Pair	1 to 1

### **Six Card Bonus Payout Odds**

Royal Flush	1000 to 1
Straight Flush	200 to 1
Four of a Kind	50 to 1
Full House	25 to 1
Flush	20 to 1
Straight	10 to 1
3 of a Kind	5 to 1

## ADDITIONAL SIDE WAGERS

Six Card Bonus Bet – the player needs to form a 5-card poker hand of 3 of a Kind or higher using the player's three cards and the Dealer's three cards. This gives players the chance to win a maximum payout of 1,000 to 1 on the wager.

Progressive Jackpot Wager – is an additional side wager that gives players the chance to win a jackpot prize with a maximum payout of 100% of the Progressive Jackpot displayed on the table.
